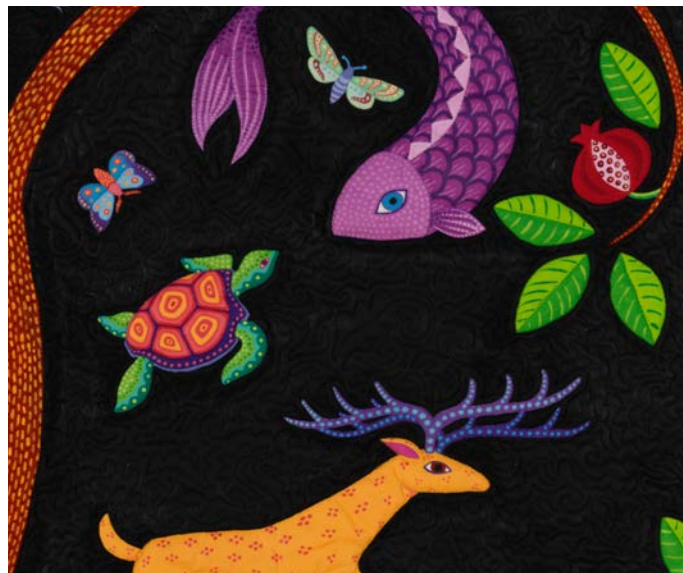

Paint offers endless opportunities for creating special effects on fabric, from adding details, dimension or shadow to creating fully illustrated scenes.

While working with textile paints, students learn to control paint bleeding, paint backgrounds and fill large areas evenly, avoiding blotchiness, learn techniques for creating gradations of color, glazing paint to create more visual depth, and how to work with freezer paper masks, as well as paint fine lines and details.

Learning how different paints affect the hand of the fabric, and how to baste painted fabric for quilting will also be covered.

This is an information packed class geared to help students gain confidence painting on fabric for art quilting.

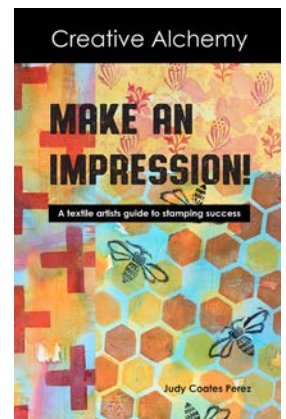
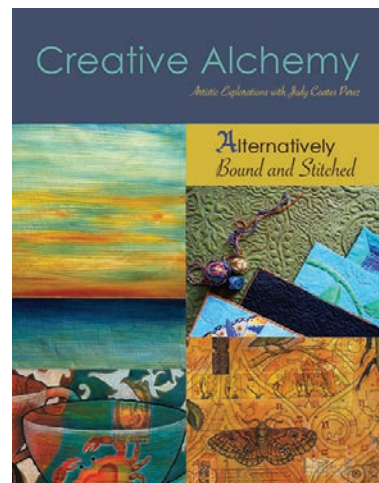
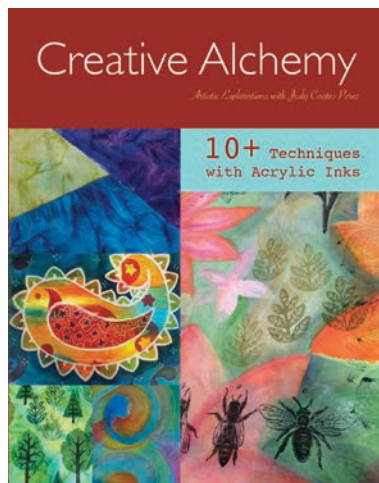
