Society for the Prevention and Eradication of Quilts Stalled (SPEQS) Challenge

(Formerly the RCQG UFO Challenge)

GOALS: The **ERADICATION** (completion) of stalled quilts – formerly known as UFOs – and the **PREVENTION** of new stalled quilts.

ERADICATION: Stalled quilts are those quilt projects that you have actually started, but which were unfinished as of Dec. 31, 2018. Any quilt kit purchased before Dec. 31, 2018 is considered a **stalled quilt** for this challenge. Sorry, a stack of purchased fabric is not yet a stalled quilt.

PREVENTION: Any quilt project started and completed within 60 days during 2019 will qualify as a successful **stalled quilt prevention**, making the quilter eligible for drawings and prizes as well. SPEQS Prevention Reporting forms will be available at guild meetings.

HOW TO JOIN: List up to 10 **stalled quilt projects** with identifying information that you would like to complete during 2019 on the **SPEQS Stalled Quilts Register**. If you complete 10 stalled quilts you may submit additional registers throughout the year.

Submit the **SPEQS Stalled Quilts Register** and Membership Fee to the SPEQS Coordinator at a guild meeting or mail to **Marie Nelson** at 1629 Castec Drive, Sacramento, CA 95864 or by email to QNOP@comcast.net. Your **Stalled Quilts Prevented** may be added to the reporting form at guild meetings.

MEMBERSHIP FEE: \$5.00 **NO ENTRY DEADLINE:** Open throughout the year, but there will be monthly prize drawings for projects completed and reported each month.

AWARDS

Monthly drawings will be held for prizes for those reporting the completion and or prevention of a stalled quilt and showing it during guild meeting.

Annual Awards will be made to the three participants with the highest total points at the December Holiday Party. Each **Stalled Quilt Eradicated** (completed) will be worth **10 points**. Each **Stalled Quilt Prevented** will be worth **7 points**.
