



River City Quilters' Guild Block of the Month 2022

JANUARY

Each block finishes at 12" x 12". All seams are 1/4 inch. Your prepared block should measure 12.5" x 12.5". Save any extra units, strips, or scraps for future blocks.



Recommended: Strip piecing (step 1). Cut one strip WOF (width of fabric) 2.5" wide of the feature fabric "F" and one of your color C. Follow the steps below. Save any unused portion for a future segments or future blocks.


1. Strip piecing:

Cut one (1) strip of the white feature print F: 2.5" x 30.5"


Cut one (1) strip color C: 2.5" x 30.5"



Strip piece the feature fabric F with your fabric C and cut subunits (see below).



OR



Make four corner units using your strip pieced units or individual squares (cut 2 1/2" x 2 1/2")

2. Sew the two 30.5-inch strips together on one the long side. Press seam allowances toward the dark or press open, as you prefer. Trim one end of the strip set about 1/8 inch to straighten the end, then subcut twelve (12) units that measure 2.5" x 4.5". This block uses 8 units. Save the other four (4) units for February's block.

3. **Corner units:**

Cut four (4) rectangles of the white feature print F: 2.5" x 4.5"
Sew four units, finishing at 4.5" x 4.5"


4. **Center:**

Cut one (1) center square from color A: 2.5" x 2.5"

5. **Assembly:**

Lay out the units. Sew the three rows together to form the center square. On the top and bottom rows, press away from the center unit. Press toward the center dark square of the center row. Or press seams open as you prefer.

Cut four (4) rectangles from fabric B: 1.5" x 11.5"



Add the four rectangles log-cabin style, stitching the first strip only part way, then adding the second, third and fourth strips. Finish sewing the first strip to the block. Press. Finished!
